Maple and Willov Autumn News




Alongside Theme work about Elizabeth I, Maple and Willow Classes have been learning all about colour.

Sycamore Class


This term we visited a range of environments to look at different habitats where animals live.




decorating our salt-dough Diva lamps and


vegetable yoghurt dip for our Naan breads.
