The Grove School Concepts of print suggested lesson format

Suggested activities related to what children will learn.

- Adults picks up book incorrectly, encourage children to correct adult in a fun way.
- Put a selection of books on the floor/table. Allow the children to choose a book and hold the correct way up.
- Ask the children to choose a book. Look on the front cover and predict what the story is about.
- Use the big book to explain terminology.
- Ask children to be authors and illustrators.
- Use a selection of flashcards titles, children match the title to the correct book.
- Use ORT/Oxford Literacy web cards.
- Play games using ORT/Oxford Literacy Web cards.
- Give children a selection of books from different countries and show them the way that print goes.
- Use big hand or pointer to point to words in the correct order.
- Card games using ORT/Oxford Literacy Web.
- Magnetic letters.
- CVC jigsaws.
- Big book with plastic cover over for circling words and letters.
- Sentences with spaces and without identify the ones that are incorrect.
- Give the children a selection of books, children sort into categories of fiction and non-fiction.
- Find fiction books and non-fiction books in the library.
